What is The Hour of Code?

The Hour of Code (www.code.org) is an international action that aims to raise society's awareness of what computer science and informatics are as a branch of scientific and technological knowledge.



The Hour of Code does not aim to teach a new skill in such a short time - that would be completely impossible - but to provide young people with an opportunity to learn in a fun way some fundamental programming concepts: what is a cycle, a conditional decision, or how discover logic errors in computational information processing. The fundamental objective is for everyone involved to have the

opportunity to better understand the importance of skills associated with computational thinking ("Computational Thinking"), understood as a new fundamental literacy for the future.
