- -Next steps for a team professional development in the year to come.
- -Based on the results, we have developed our policy plan for the year 2023 2024 on how to promote technology and digitalisation in our school

We will be based on the Essential Digital Skills (EDS) professional development program, which is a competency framework, which sets out essential digital skills for life and work. Therefore, we will follow for the year 2023 - 2024 training in essential digital skills that Selfie for Teachers revealed that we – as school teachers – need improvement.
