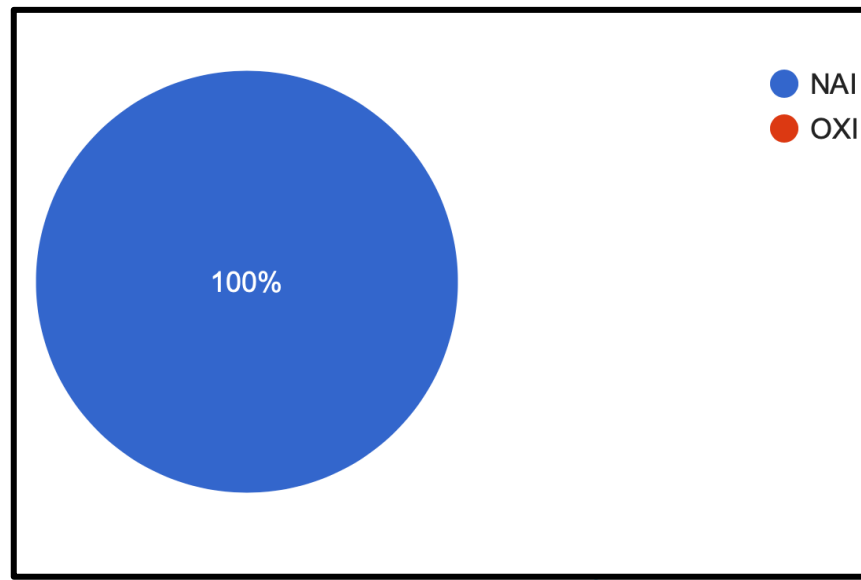
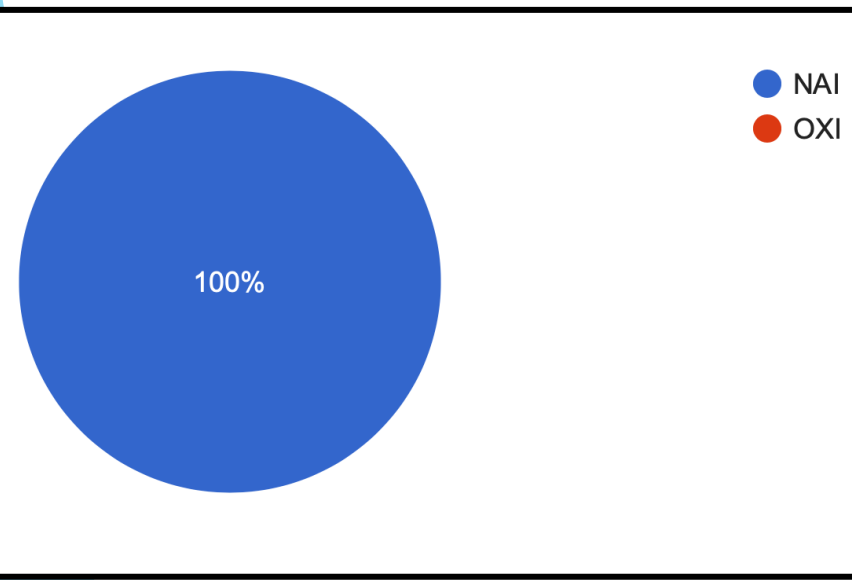


Investigating

Students' Digital Skills

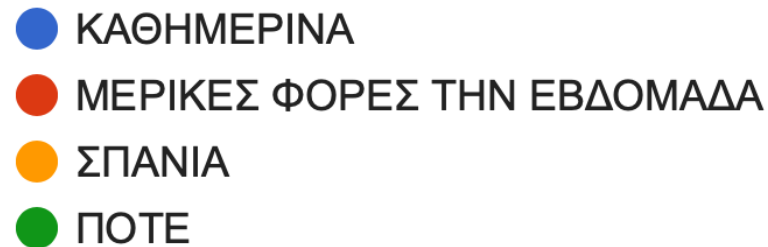
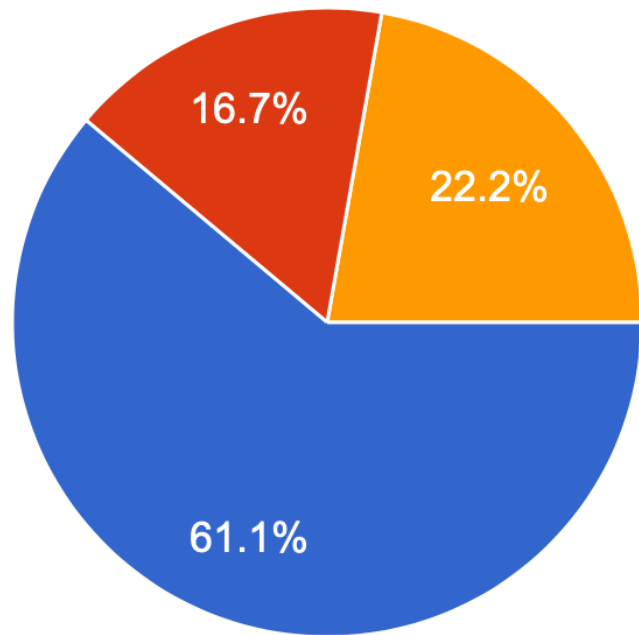
Year 5 and Year 6 Students of Makedonitissa B' Primary School Students completed a questionnaire that investigated their digital skills.

Here are some of the most interesting results.

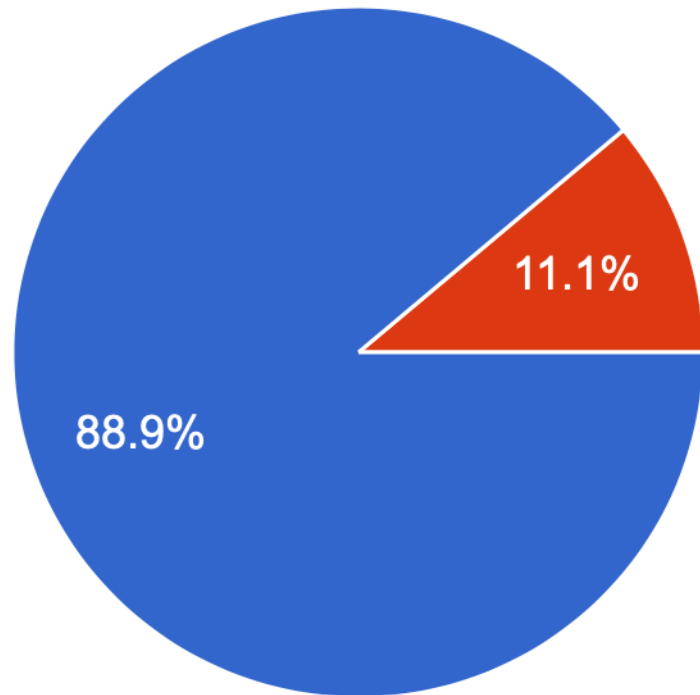
- All students asked (100%) have at least one form of computer, tablet or smartphone at home and all of them use it.



- When asked how often they use their computer/tablet or smartphone,
61% replied that they used it daily,
17% sometimes a week
22% rarely and 0% replied never.



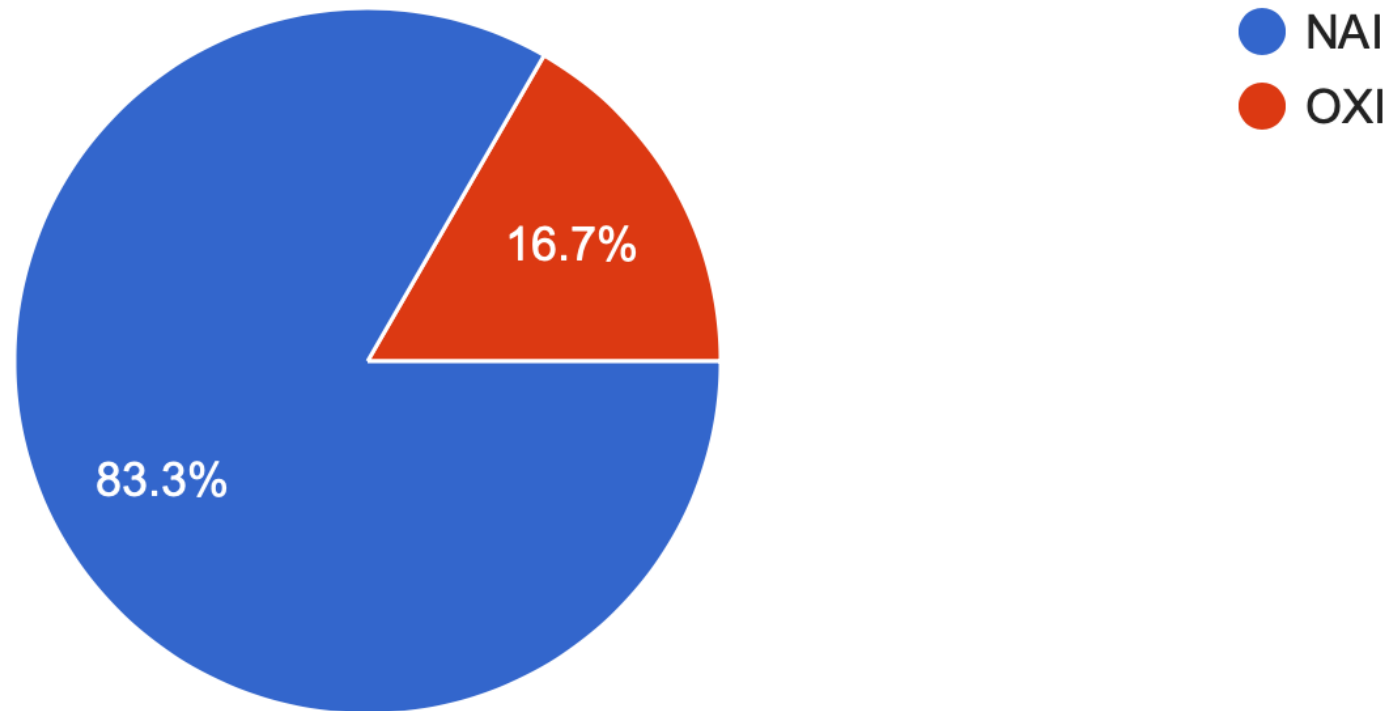
- Almost 90% of the students asked, replied that they are able to search online by themselves and find information they need while 11% of the students stated that they were unable to do so.

- Around 80% of the students stated that they have used some form of educational programs or applications in their classrooms before while only 17% replied that they never used any.



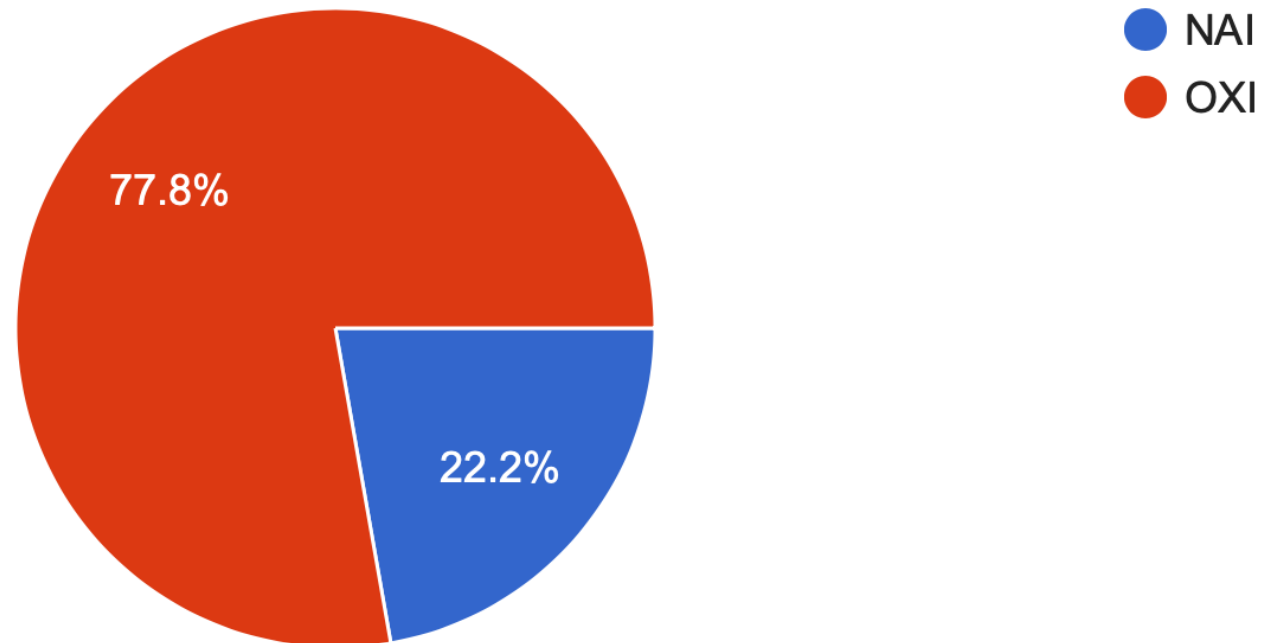


A big percentage of the students participated in the survey replied that:

- ▶ they know how to type accurately and quickly
- ▶ they know how to use an e-mail and they are using it as a form of communication (78%)
- ▶ they have created a word document or a presentation before and have been using it during their lessons (72%)
- ▶ they have used programs for editing pictures and videos before (72%)



- On the other hand, the majority of the students asked (78%) stated that they do not know how to use some form of cloud services to save and retrieve data.



• Concerning **Internet Safety Issues**, most of the students stated that they know how to safely search online (72%) and follow internet safety rules, and that they have been trained at some point at school about Internet Safety (89%).
