



Year 5 and Year & Students of Makedonitissa B' Primary School Students completed a questionnaire that investigated their digital skills. Here are some of the most interesting results.

• All students asked (100%) have at least one form of computer, tablet or smartphone at home and all of them use it.




- When asked how often they use their computer/tablet or smartphone,

 Almost 90% of the students asked, replied that they are able to search online by themselves and find information they need while 11% of the students stated that they were unable to do so.





A big percentage of the students participated in the survey replied that:


they know how to type accurately and quickly

they have used programs for editing pictures and videos before (72%)

• On the other hand, the majority of the students asked (78%) stated that they do not know how to use some form of cloud services to save and retrieve data.
